

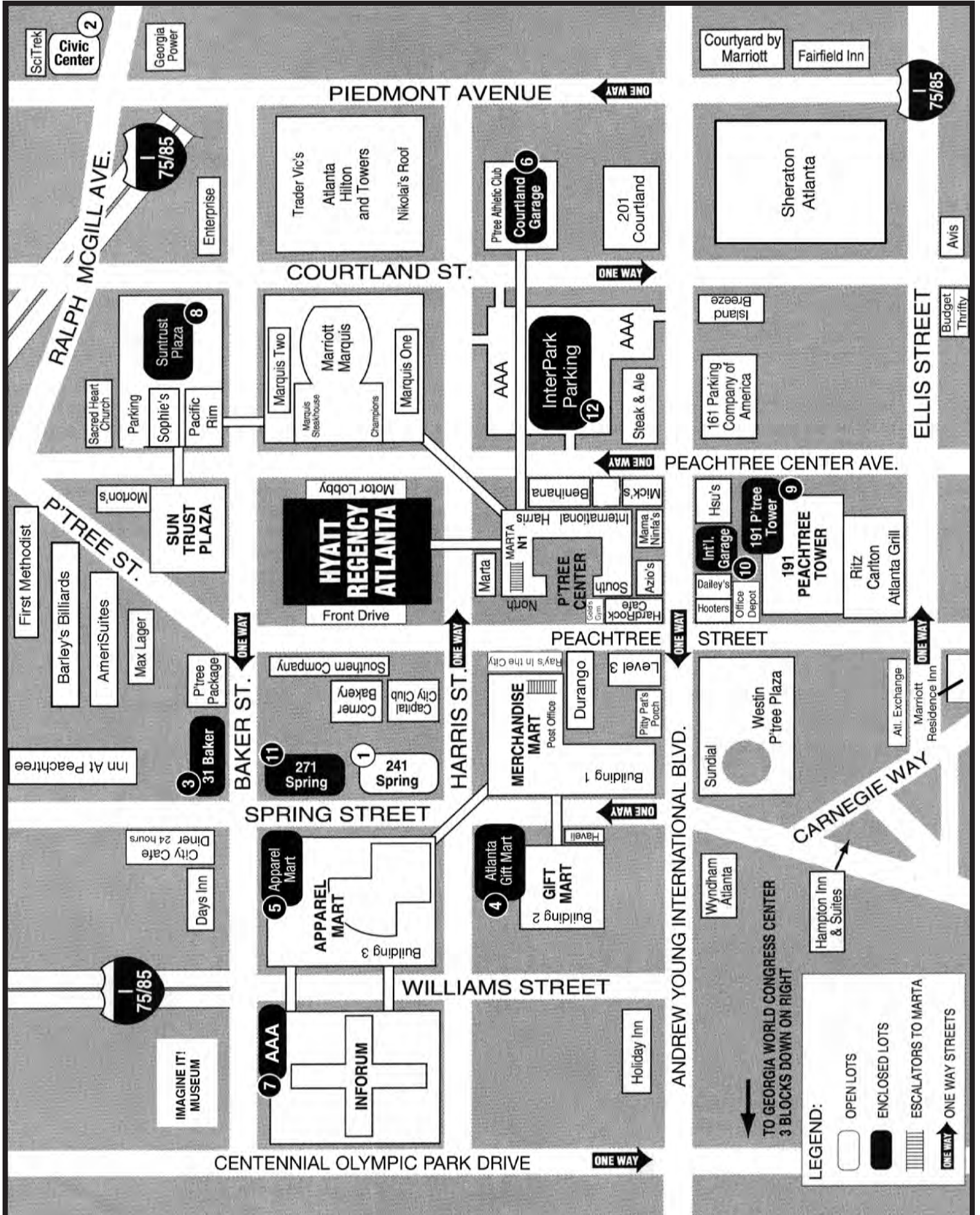

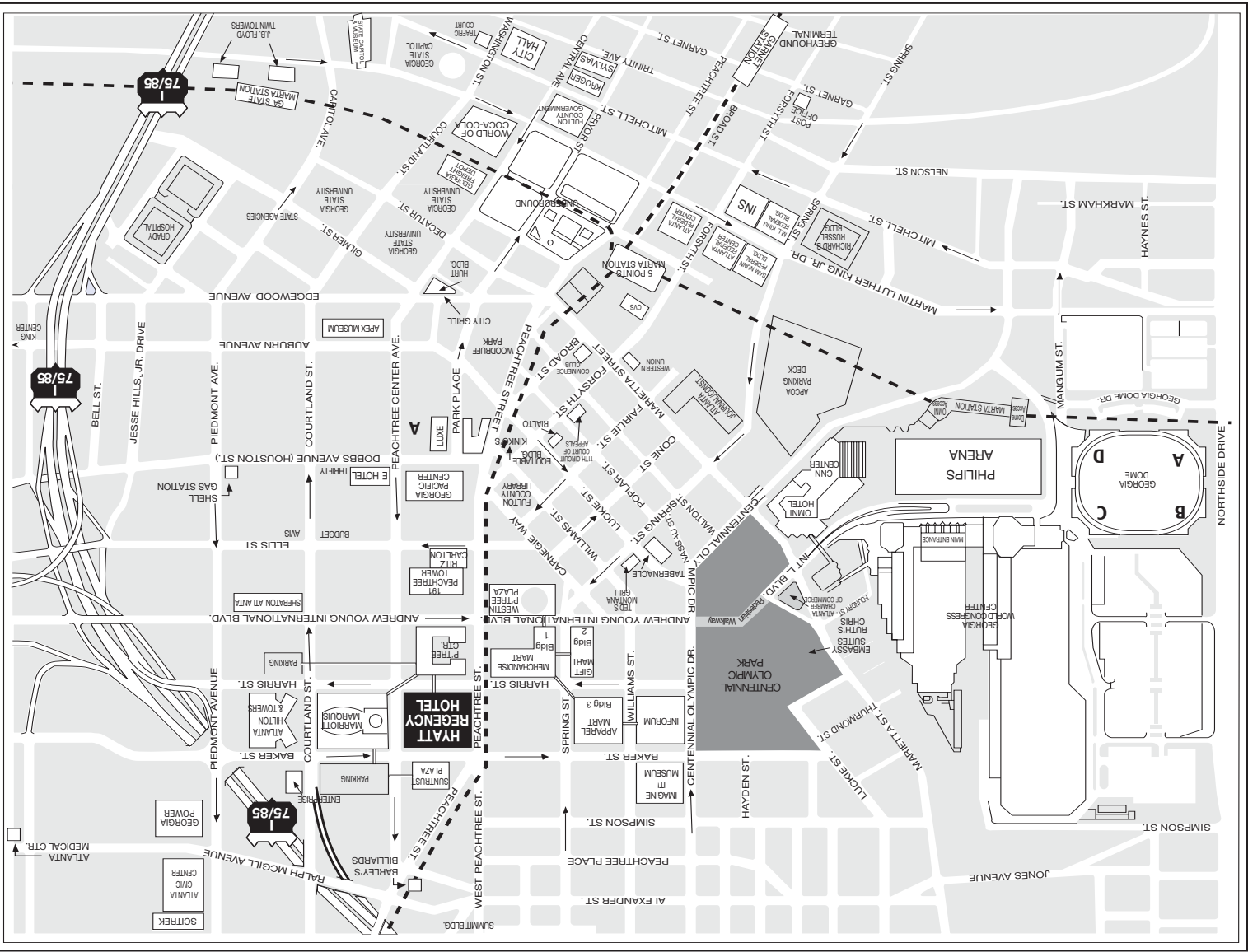
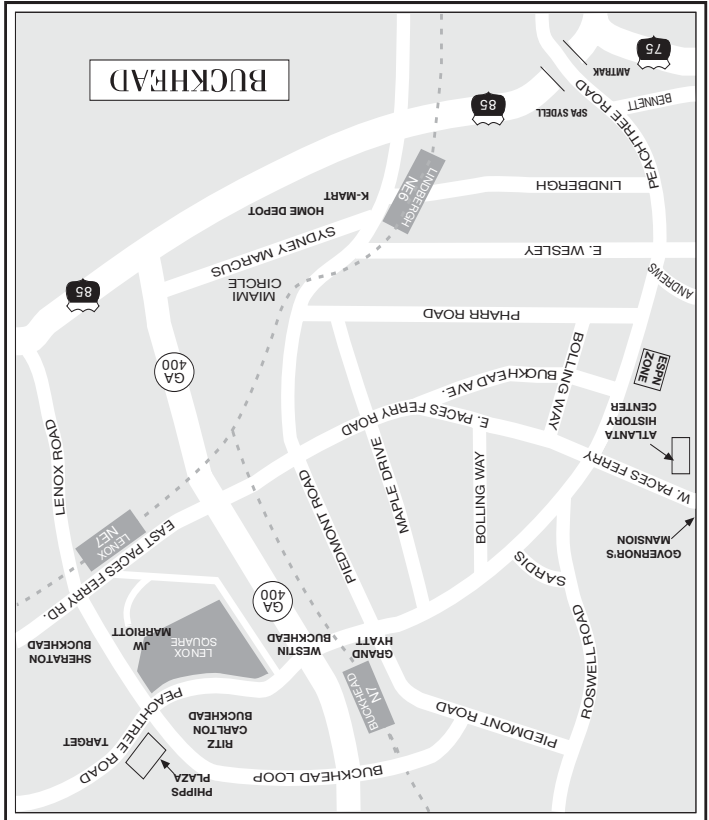

MIDTOWN • Just north of Downtown and South of Buckhead is Virginia-Highland. It is one of Atlanta's Unique Shopping areas, which includes trendy boutiques, innovative galleries, and antique shops.
